

Tricity Craft Beer Trail REGULATIONS

I. DEFINITIONS

1. Tricity Craft Beer Trail - The Organizer's tourist project in cooperation with Tricity's craft breweries. Its aim is to promote the long-standing local traditions of brewing and to become a new tourist attraction both *for the residents of Gdańsk* and *for tourists*. The Craft Beer Trail is not intended to promote the consumption of alcohol or the promotion of alcoholic beverages.
2. **Organizer** - Gdańsk Tourism Organization with its registered office in Gdańsk (80-530) at ul. Uczniowska 22, entered into the register of associations, other social and professional organizations, foundations and independent public health care institutions of the National Court Register, maintained by the District Court for Gdańsk-Północ in Gdańsk under KRS number 0000139108, holding Tax Identification Number (NIP) 5832887298.
3. **Partner** - an entity participating in the Tricity Craft Beer Trail, which offers its products – on the basis of contracts concluded with the Organizer – to the Tricity Craft Beer Trail Participants under specific conditions set out in the Regulations.
4. **Premises** - premises of the Partner, which are part of Tricity Craft Beer Trail. The Trial consists of the following premises:
 - 1) Browar Miejski Sopot – ul. Bohaterów Monte Cassino 35, Sopot
 - 2) Lubrow Gdańsk – ul. Karmelicka 1, Gdańsk
 - 3) Lubrow Sopot – ul. Bohaterów Monte Cassino 60, Sopot
 - 4) Pub Browar Spółdzielczy – al. Grunwaldzka 190, Gdańsk
 - 5) Brovarnia Hotel Gdańsk – ul. Szafarnia 9, Gdańsk
 - 6) Browar Vrest – ul. Słowackiego 23, Gdańsk
 - 7) AleBrowar – ul. Starowiejska 40B, 81-001 Gdynia
 - 8) Konsulat Dobrego Piwa – ul. Gen. W. Sikorskiego 12, 81-827 Sopot
 - 9) PG4 – ul. Podwale Grodzkie 4, Gdańsk
 - 10) Cathead – ul. Powroźnicza 19/20, 80-828 Gdańsk
 - 11) Browar Port - Bulwar Nadmorski im. Feliksa Nowowiejskiego 2, 81-371 Gdynia

5. **Tricity Craft Beer Trail Participant** - a person of age, holding a Passport.
6. **Passport** - an element of the Organizer's information brochure handed out at the Premises, at Tourist Information Points run by the Organizer and at the Organizer's stands during events promoting individual tourism in Gdańsk. The Passport contains fields to place Stamps confirming visits at the Premises and making a purchase of at least one beer of any kind therein. A maximum of 8 stamps can be placed in one Passport.
7. **Stamp** - a graphic symbol placed at the Premises by its employees in the Passport confirming the visit at the Premises and the purchase of at least one beer of any kind therein.

II. THE RULES FOR THE PARTICIPATION IN THE Tricity Craft Beer Trail

1. Each Tricity Craft Beer Trail Participant – in the case of visiting the Premises and purchasing at least one beer of any kind – is entitled to receive a Stamp therein. Each Tricity Craft Beer Trail Participant, when applying for a stamp at the Premises, declares that s/he agrees to the provisions of these Regulations.
2. At each Premises, any Tricity Craft Beer Trail Participant may obtain a maximum of one Stamp.
3. Each Tricity Craft Beer Trail Participant may collect stamps only in one Passport until it is completely filled.
4. Each Tricity Craft Beer Trail Participant is obliged not to consume excessive amounts of alcohol at the Premises.

III. PRIZES

1. Each Craft Beer Trail Participant, who has obtained the required amount of Stamps shall be entitled to a prize specified in these Regulations. After receiving one of the partial prizes, the Stamps can be still collected. In such a case, the Craft Beer Trail Participant – after obtaining more Stamps – will not be issued prizes the equivalent of which have already been issued (for one Passport only one prize of a given kind can be collected). Any issuing of a prize shall be recorded in the Passport.
2. The Organizer provides the following prizes :
 - a. in the case of a Craft Beer Trail Participant obtaining 3 Stamps, s/he will receive a beer saver with the Craft Beer Trail logo.
 - b. in the case of a Craft Beer Trail Participant obtaining 5 Stamps, s/he will receive a beer saver + 4 coasters with the Craft Beer Trail logo
 - c. in the case of a Craft Beer Trail Participant obtaining 7 Stamps, s/he will receive a beer saver, 4 coasters and a bottle opener with the Craft Beer Trail logo.
 - d. in the case of a Craft Beer Trail Participant obtaining 9 Stamps, s/he will receive a beer saver, 4 coasters, a bottle opener and a T-shirt with the Craft Beer Trail logo.

e. in the case of a Craft Beer Trail Participant obtaining 11 Stamps, s/he will receive a beer saver, 4 coasters, a bottle opener, a T-shirt and a beer glass with the Craft Beer Trail logo.

3. The basis for receiving a prize is to collect a certain number of Stamps in the Tricity Craft Beer Trail Passport. Passports cannot be combined.
4. The prizes will be issued by the Organizer at the Gdańsk Tourist Information Centre, ul. Długi Targ 28/29 during the opening hours upon presentation of a filled Passport and submission thereof to the Organizer's employee. Copies of the Passport will not be accepted. Prizes shall be issued after filling in and handing over a Prize Collection Form , which has been attached as Appendix No. 1 to the Regulations .
5. In case of doubts regarding the age of a Tricity Craft Beer Trail Participant, the Organizer may request the Tricity Craft Beer Trail Participant to present a document with a photo confirming his/her age.
6. Apart from the prizes specified above, the Tricity Craft Beer Trail Participants shall not be entitled to any other claims against the Organizer. The Craft Beer Trail Participants may not swap the prizes for cash equivalent or exchange them for other prizes.

IV. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The Regulations shall enter into force on January 1, 2018 and shall remain in force until all prizes are exhausted. However, the Organizer may cancel the validity of the Regulations, as well as the Tricity Craft Beer Trail at any time.
2. The Regulations are available at the Premises, at the Organizer's points and on the Organizer's website visitgdansk.com.
3. The Organizer is entitled to change the Regulations. Such changes will be made public by posting it on the website visitgdansk.com with the date of the change coming into force.
4. The Organizer shall not refund any costs to the Craft Beer Trail Participants, related to their participation in the Tricity Craft Beer Trail.
5. Participation in the Tricity Craft Beer Trail is voluntary. The Craft Beer Trail Participants agree to the collection and processing of their personal data by the Organizer for the purpose of the organization of the Craft Beer Trail. The Participants are entitled to view and correct their personal data. The Organizer is the Administrator of the personal data collected in connection with the Craft Beer Trail; it shall be entitled to transfer and make such data available to other parties cooperating in the execution of the Competition and in any future advertising or marketing actions.
6. The following appendices shall constitute an integral part of these Regulations:

7. In all matters not regulated by these Regulations, the applicable laws shall apply.
